FamilyLife

My last update mentioned the plans to move FamilyLife's headquarters from Little Rock to Orlando in two phases. Phase one was completed August 31st. The headquarters building has been sold and FamilyLife is renting back a small portion of space for staff needs during phase two. FamilyLife has decided to increase emphasis on community outreach, which will require additional field staff to build into local lay leaders located in key cities around the USA. The Weekend To Remember Conference and FamilyLife Today broadcast (also podcast / streaming) will remain as key elements of our overall outreach.

The Pandemic

The lockdown of 2020 has certainly impacted everything. About mid-March FamilyLife staff vacated our office space in the headquarters building and we all began to work remotely from home. We all have added a new word and capability to our skill set, "Zoom." The team

has recently released several ministry tools with more in process as new FamilyLife resources.

- 6. Dates to Remember A brand new project to be released this fall.


My Personal Update
